INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES SHORTLISTED FOR WRITTEN TEST

With reference to the above advertisement, applications were invited for the post of Assistant Professor – Grade II. As per the General Instructions / Intimation mentioned in the advertisement, the new entrants have to appear for the written test on the specified Date for the department applied for the post of Assistant Professor - Grade II, at the venue, **Third-i, Octagon, National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirappalli**. The date and time may be found in the intimation mail sent to the candidates, and are also available in the recruitment website i.e., <https://recruitment.nitt.edu/>.

Instructions to the Shortlisted Candidates:

1. Intimation mail for the written test has been sent to the candidates to their registered email. No separate communication in the form of letter will be sent.
2. Check the intimation email carefully and bring the discrepancies, if any, to the notice of the Institute immediately (recruitcell@nitt.edu)
3. Candidate should mention his/her Name, Registration ID and Department in all his /her correspondences.
4. The candidature to the written test is provisional.
5. Please bring the print out of the intimation mail along with the (original) Photo Identity Card, to secure admission to Examination Hall.
6. The entry into the written test Venue shall be closed 30 minutes before the scheduled commencement of the test. No candidate shall be allowed into the Examination Venue after closure of the entry points. The candidate will be permitted to leave the examination hall only at the end of the examination.
7. Candidate should not be in possession of or using any mobile phone (even in switched off mode), pager or any electronic equipment or programmable device or storage media like pen drive, smartwatches, etc., or camera or Bluetooth devices or any other equipment or related accessories either in working or switched off mode capable of being used as a communication device during the examination. Any infringement of these instructions will lead to the rejection of the application.
8. Use of normal or simple wristwatches and non-programmable scientific calculator by candidates is allowed inside the Examination Rooms/Halls. However, use of watches fitted with any special accessory that might be used as communication device or smart watches is strictly prohibited and candidates are not allowed to take such watches into the Examination Rooms/Halls.
9. Candidates are advised not to bring any valuables/ costly items and bags to the Examination Venue. The Institute will not be responsible for any loss in this regard.
10. Written Examination will consist of Objective Type Questions with 25% negative marking for each wrong answer and the duration is for two hours.
11. The department-wise syllabus can be found in the Institute website.
12. The Institute does not provide accommodation for candidates / accompanying persons at the time of the Written Test / Presentation / Interview.
13. Based on the performance in the Written Test, candidates will be shortlisted for the subsequent selection process i.e., Department Presentation and Interview after Certificate Verification.
14. The provisionally shortlisted candidates, after written examination, have to appear for certificate verification with the original documents mentioned in intimation mail/letter failing which they will not be allowed for Department Presentation / Interview.
15. The decision of the Institute in this regard is final.
16. All the candidates are advised to comply with the respective protocols of the Central/State Government on COVID -19. The candidate will be denied permission to enter the examination hall, if he/she violates the COVID -19 directives/advisories of Government (Central/State) applicable on the day of examination.
